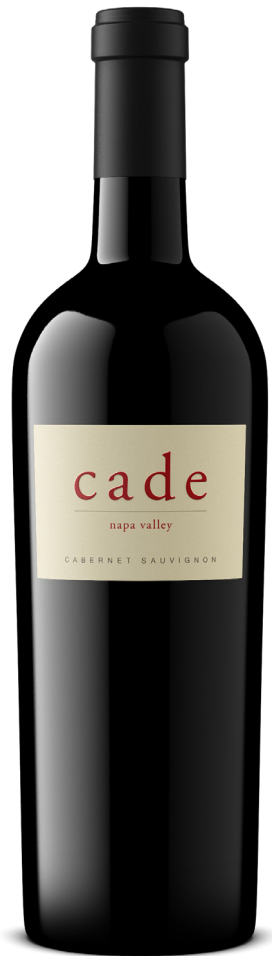


2019 CADE CABERNET SAUVIGNON, NAPA VALLEY

VINEYARD NOTES

The cade napa valley Cabernet Sauvignon is made from two of Napa's most renowned vineyards: Kenefick Ranch Vineyards in Calistoga and Hanson-Hsieh Vineyard in Oak Knoll. We picked the fruit from these vineyards from September 25–October 15, 2019.

ÉLEVAGE

The wine received 18 months barrel aging in 100% French Oak (58% new). Malolactic fermentation occurred in barrel immediately after primary fermentation. The wine was racked quarterly once malolactic fermentation was complete.

COOPERAGE

We used several different coopers, including Allary, Atelier, Tonnellerie O, Nadalie, Taransaud, Quintessence, Saint Martin, and Mercier. The oak for these coopers was sourced from several different forests and the toasting levels were a combination of Medium and Medium Long.

IMPRESSIONS

The 2019 cade Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, has beautiful aromas of blackberry, black cherry, boysenberry, vanilla, clove, brown spices, white pepper, rose petals, and dark chocolate, followed by flavors of fresh purple fruits, chocolate-covered cherries, cinnamon, and raspberry. The Petit Verdot adds structure, weight, and inky dark color to this wine, and velvety and lush tannins demonstrate what valley-floor fruit can offer.
