
Hanifaru Snorkeling at UNESCO Bioshere

Please note, sightings are subject to weather conditions and the behavior of these gentle oceanic giants. Hanifaru Bay, a protected marine area, prohibits diving but permits snorkeling. Visits are regulated based on specific dates and times. Bookings are always taken a day before during the the season.

Attention divers aged 75 or older:

New insurance policies from DAN require a medical certificate from a physician. The certificate must confirm your fitness to dive, current health status, medications, and dosages. Please email this certificate to diveOceanus to ensure clearance for diving activities. Send details at least 10 days before your arrival to royalisland@diveoceanus.com. We'll notify you upon receiving the necessary documentation. Please note, the final approval for scuba diving remains with DAN or an alternative insurance provider.
