## Points of interest:

- A Restored water fountains dating back to the French Protectorate.
- B Hand-made Moroccan carved white plaster inspired by the Saadian patterns.
- Display of a textile pattern book archive dating from the 1920s in a «Tadelakt» stripe stair representing water, fire and air.
- Mosaic «Zellige» with the same pattern found in the original house before the refurbishment.

- © Orientalist painters Gharbaoul & Bertuchi interwined in ochre tone.
- E Little street that provided access to original Moroccan houses «Riads».
- Gilded copper entrance door with the inscription in the Tadlack of «Kan Ya Makan» (Once upon a time), similar to the door of the Mausoleum of the Saadian Princes.
