La Sultana Marrakech is a boutique, luxury hotel and a hidden gem of quintessential Moroccan charm and glamour within the old Imperial City Walls. Flowered patios with palms, sago palms and banana trees make La Sultana an oasis of calm away from the hustle and bustle of the Kasbah.

## ACCOMMODATION

La Sultana Marrakech comprises 28 individually designed rooms and suites located within five adjoining riads (traditional Moroccan houses with central patio and windows overlooking the interior rather than the outdoor). Sprawling corridors and hidden chambers ensure ultimate privacy.

With high vaulted ceilings, marble columns, precious woods, Tadelakt (traditional Moroccan Plaster technique) and copper finishes the rooms and suites provide sophistication and elegance.

The Exclusive Suite – ‘The Lion’s Apartment’ spans 1,000 sqft and the sheer whiteness of the place is enticing. It features a separate living room with its own fireplace and desk, two bathrooms, and a private terrace.

## RATES

Rates start from 7000 MAD per night for a Riad Room in low season.

## LOCATION

La Sultana Marrakech is located within the UNESCO protected medina, a stone’s throw from all the historical sites including the Saadian Tombs, Royal Palace, Bahia Palace and 10 minutes’ walk to Djemma El Fna (the main square).

15 minutes’ drive from the airport.

## ROOF TERRACE

La Sultana's rooftop terrace is the largest in the medina. It's an elegant space with green cushions and traditional Moroccan tiling inspired by the hanging gardens of Babylon with panoramic views of Marrakech and the Atlas Mountains.

The acclaimed bar and restaurant (The Odette Bar & La Table du Souk) on the roof terrace serve signature cocktails and mouth-watering local dishes throughout the day.

The roof terrace hosts daily cooking classes.

## FOOD & BEVERAGE

La Sultana Marrakech celebrates Morocco's culinary heritage and outstanding local produce sourcing ingredients from a small network of local producers and La Sultana's very own organic gardens and the local market.

The chef applies French techniques to Moroccan food, providing the best of Moroccan cooking with the best of French cuisine.

La Table de La Sultana is the poolside patio garden restaurant, which provides French and Moroccan cuisine and is open for dinner every day between 7.30pm and 10pm for guests and non-resident guests.

La Table du Souk is the terrace rooftop restaurant offering views as far as the eye can see of Marrakech and the snow-capped Atlas Mountains whilst enjoying exceptional Moroccan dishes from The Market menu and the Street Food menu. La Table du Souk is open for lunch every day between 12:30pm and 3pm for guests and non-resident guests.

Odette Rooftop Bar & Mezzé takes over between 4pm and 10pm with cosmopolite cuisine served on the spacious outdoor terrace overlooking the UNESCO listed Medina of Marrakech.





## ALFRESCO COOKING CLASSES

La Sultana Marrakech hosts daily cooking classes every morning on the roof terrace beginning with a mint tea ritual and finishing with indulging in the food cooked during the class.

Traditional Moroccan dishes cooked include taktouka, marinated zucchini and chicken, fish or vegetable tagine.



## SPA & WELLNESS

La Sultana Marrakech's award-winning spa is a secret hideaway with sensuously pleasing interiors including crimson marble walls, wrought iron lanterns and a glistening turquoise pool.

Offering traditional Moroccan treatments including the famous Royal Hammam using black soap made from pressed olives and decadent massages using locally sourced essential oils. All treatments are individually tailored to promote health and relaxation.

Facilities include 3 Hammams, jacuzzi, sauna, beauty center, hairdresser, 5 massage rooms.



## HISTORY

The building was handed down to a former palace worker - Caid Azzi Boujemaa - as a gift for his devotion and loyalty to the dynasty.

During the French protectorate, his son lovingly restored many of its original features and the address became synonymous with glamorous society balls and parties.

In 2001 in partnership with Historical Monuments Organisation it was revived once again.

Today La Sultana Marrakech captures the charm and elegance of residences from a bygone era.
