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## *a brief history*

### • 1995

- Tucked in the heart of Napa Valley's Oakville AVA, PlumpJack Estate became the first winery in our portfolio in 1995, opening in 1997.

### • 2005

- CADE Estate Winery is the second to join our portfolio, with 54 acres sitting at 1800 ft above sea level on the dramatic slopes of Howell Mountain. The winery opened in 2009.

### 2016

- Inspiring its namesake as the thirteenth bonded winery in California, 13th Vineyard by CADE becomes the fourth winery in our portfolio, making us the largest landowners on Howell Mountain.

### 1992

Gavin Newsom establishes PlumpJack Wines on Filmore Street in San Francisco with a vision of creating a wine-buying experience that was approachable and non-intimidating.

### • 1998

John Conover becomes General Manager of PlumpJack Estate Winery (and future partner in CADE and Odette Estate Wineries), working towards building an estate dedicated to crafting a wine reflective of its appellation.

### • 2012

- Nestled in the Stags Leap District AVA, Odette Estate becomes the third winery in our portfolio and the second to achieve LEED Gold Certification.

### • 2022

- By acquiring the 129-acre Oso Vineyard, we've secured the future of our portfolio and the primary source of fruit for Adaptation.





As the crow flies, about a half mile over from lies the seldom-told story of an extraordinary winery, 13th Vineyard by CADE.

Its roots inspired the winery's namesake as the thirteenth bonded winery in California, dating back to the 1800s when Jean Brun, a native of Bordeaux, and Jean V. Chaix, were one of the first to plant Medoc grapes on the Estate. In 1886, the duo built a three-story gravity-fed winery made of stone.

Acquiring this property allowed us to rediscover the past and grow into the future, evolving the production of our Estate-driven wines, many of which we now make in this historic stone winery.

# CADE Estate was the first LEED Gold Certified winery in Napa Valley and one of Northern California's architectural treasures.

The volcanic soil and steep grades create excellent drainage resulting in dense, concentrated fruit character while cloud inversion allows maximum daily sun exposure and increased photosynthesis which develops phenolic ripeness as compared to sugar ripeness.

Sitting at an elevation of 1,800 on Howell Mountain, our state-of-the-art winery affords panoramic views from the valley floor to the Mayacamas Mountains and as far south as Mount Diablo.





# *Meet Danielle Cyrot*

## **WINEMAKER, CADE ESTATE WINERY & 13<sup>TH</sup> VINEYARD**

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Growing up with a French father, Danielle spent summers as a child in France, where she learned about her family's winemaking history. Her great-grandfather was the last in a long line of ancestors who owned the Cyrot vineyard in Burgundy's prestigious Côte de Beaune.

Danielle had no plans to carry on her family's winemaking legacy when she enrolled at the University of California, Davis; however, that quickly changed when she took an introductory winemaking class and knew she had found her calling. While at Davis, she worked harvests at Schramsberg and Artesa in Napa Valley, learning the trade from the soil up. After graduating with a Bachelor of Science degree in viticulture and enology, Danielle worked abroad at wineries in Alsace, France, and South Australia.

After honing her skills overseas, Danielle returned to Napa Valley and joined Stags' Leap Winery as their Enologist. They quickly recognized her talent, promoting her to Assistant Winemaker under her mentor, Robert Brittan. During her six-year tenure, she produced world-class wines that merited her next promotion as Winemaker at St. Clement. Danielle spent the next seven years crafting elegant, structured, and notable wines that expressed her personality and what she likes in a glass of wine. In August 2012, she joined CADE Estate Winery and has become one of the most innovative, sustainability-minded winemakers in Napa Valley. Her work has helped dismantle the status quo, reframing screw caps as an acceptable closure for high-end wines and defining the next generation of luxury wine packaging.

# 2022 CADE Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley

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## VINTAGE

In 2022, 33% of the fruit came from our newly acquired Oso Vineyard in Pope Valley, 15% from PlumpJack Estate in Oakville, 8% from 13th Vineyard on Howell Mountain. We also worked with three other properties: Stanley Vineyard in Oak Knoll (18%), Berggruen in St. Helena (14%), and Juliana Vineyard in Pope Valley (12%). The grapes were harvested from August 17th through September 3rd, 2022.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

Fermentation was carried out in a combination of stainless-steel tanks and drums (87%) and French oak barrels (6% new). Eleven different strains of yeast were used to ferment the juice. Fermentation lasted for an average of 20 days at an average temperature of 56oF with no malolactic fermentation occurring. The wine aged in Stainless steel tanks and barrels for 5 months. The barrels and stainless-steel drums were aged sur lies without stirring the lees.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

Our 2022 Sauvignon Blanc has aromas of green apple, green melon, guava, floral, honeydew melon, lemon, pineapple, ripe pear, and yuzu. On the palate are flavors of lemon curd, key lime pie, grapefruit, lemon zest, and citrus. The wine is bright, fresh, and has a great vibrant acidity on the finish. The grapes from Oso Vineyard bring out lemon, apple, and pear flavors, which we feel are great additions to this wine. The 2022 vintage was the largest production of CADE Sauvignon Blanc ever made, because of the acquisition of Oso Vineyard. The addition of Sémillon adds notes of kiwi with slight minerality, and a touch of Viognier offers textural viscosity on the palate and floral notes on the nose.

## MULTIPLE VINEYARDS


We use fruit from vineyards across Napa Valley, offering layers of flavors: classic grapefruit and lemon from Oak Knoll, green apple and melon from St. Helena, and peach, lemon curd, and pear from the warmer and more northern vineyards in Pope Valley and Howell Mountain.

## MULTIPLE FERMENTERS

Stainless-steel vessels preserve the fresh aromatics, acidity, and zest while lightly toasted French oak barrels and concrete egg provide density and viscosity.

## HOW'S IT TASTE?

Bright, fresh, and vibrant—just like spring! The addition of Sémillon adds kiwi notes along with a bit of minerality, while a touch of Viognier adds texture to the palate and floral notes on the nose.

# 2019 CADE Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Howell Mountain

## VINEYARD NOTES

The CADE Howell Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from four vineyards on Howell Mountain, including the CADE Estate Vineyard, CADE 13th Vineyard, Ink Grade Vineyard, and Cold Springs. The cooler 2019 vintage started on September 26th, with fruit from the Ink Grade Vineyard and finished on November 2nd with fruit from 13th Vineyard.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

Majority of the fermentations went through a very short maceration time between 5-7 days and hot fermentation temperatures, peaking at 92°F. The must was pressed off at between 20°-12° Brix and fermentation was allowed to finish in tank or barrel. The resulting wines have amazing color and big intensity.

## ÉLEVAGE

The wine received 19 months barrel aging in 100% French oak (80% new). Malolactic fermentation occurred in barrel immediately after primary fermentation. The wine was racked quarterly once malolactic fermentation was complete.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

In the nose are aromas of cola, blueberry, red cherry, coco nibs, baking spices, and dried cranberries. The wine has flavors of boysenberry, black cherry, elderberry, dark chocolate, clove, and licorice. The wine finishes with some bramble, amaretto, and dried blue/black fruits. The wine has classic Howell Mountain structure and tannin, big and bold but balanced in approach. The cooler 2019 vintage produced wines with higher perceived acidity and lots of red fruit flavors and aromas.

# 2019 CADE Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, Howell Mountain



## VINEYARD NOTES

The CADE Estate is situated on a 54-acre property with 21 acres planted to vines. Located in the heart of Howell Mountain, our CADE Reserve vineyards sit at elevations ranging from 1,500 to 1,850 feet and is planted Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, and Petit Verdot. The 2018 vintage also features fruit from our recently acquired 82-acre property on Howell Mountain, 13th Vineyard. Fruit was harvested from October 10th through October 29th.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

The fruit was hand-picked, destemmed/whole berry, hand sorted, and pumped into small stainless steel fermentation tanks. The must was kept at 50°F for a two-day cold soak. Fermentation was hot and fast with temperatures reaching a maximum of 92°F and the juice macerating on the skins/seeds for 6-7 days.

## ÉLEVAGE

The wine was aged for 20 months in 100% New French Oak barrels. Only free run wine was used in the blend, no press fractions were selected. Racking occurred immediately after the completion of malolactic fermentation, then on a quarterly basis until bottling.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2019 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon has aromas of blueberry, black berry, black cherry, crème de cassis, mocha, coffee, and brown spices. In the palate are flavors of black currant, cranberry, raspberry, blueberry pie, cola, and caramel. The wine is full bodied, rich, dense, and finishes with intensity, structure, and weight. The wine finishes with a thick velvety texture, and a plethora of blue and black fruits laced with dark chocolate. The Reserve Howell Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon is a selection of the best of the vintage. The best block, best barrels, and overall, a wine that reflects the best of Howell Mountain.



**2022 CADE Sauvignon Blanc,  
Napa Valley**

Our 2022 CADE Sauvignon Blanc has aromas of guava, green apple, lemon, lime, white peach, lemon grass, green melon, and orange blossom. In the palate are flavors of citrus, banana, Meyer lemon, pineapple, mango, lemon meringue, cantaloupe, and grapefruit. The wine finishes with a bright acidity, a touch of minerality, and a nice creamy mid palate texture. Fermenting the juice in stainless steel preserves the wonderful, varied fruits of the Sauvignon Blanc grape. The small portion of juice that is fermented in new French oak barrels gives the wine a bit of texture and creaminess which helps balance the natural bright acidity of the grape. The addition of Semillon brings acidity, minerality, and a touch of lemon grass to the wine. The Viognier adds the orange blossom, cantaloupe, and viscosity to the wine.

## *Meet Aaron Miller*

**WINEMAKER, PLUMPJACK ESTATE WINERY**

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As Head Winemaker for PlumpJack Winery, Aaron Miller brings over a decade of wide-ranging experience and an extensive education to the position, holding a Master of Science in Viticulture and Enology from UC Davis. A California native, he found his calling in the wine industry and planted roots in Napa. Miller is dedicated to crafting Oakville Cabernet that not only showcases the terroir of the estate's 42 acres, but also to crafting Oakville Cabernet Sauvignon in the PlumpJack style.

“My goal is always to make wine that is strong enough to stand on its own, yet elegant enough to be enjoyed with food,” says Miller. “The soil profile at PlumpJack allows for such complexity – simultaneously light and dense. That diversity necessitates preparedness. When it comes to winemaking, I think ten steps ahead, and then act. Being well prepared is critical in order to find the balance between the science and the art of winemaking.”

Miller graduated from UC Davis with a Bachelor of Science in Neurobiology, Physiology, and Behavior before continuing on to receive his Masters. After being published in the American Journal of Enology and Viticulture and interning in Italy and New Zealand, Miller held positions at Groth Winery and Lewis Cellars. Miller, a life-long fermenter, can often be found brewing beer and making cheese when not spending his spare time with his wife and family.

# 2022 PlumpJack Reserve Chardonnay, Napa Valley

## VINTAGE

Napa Valley received well below average rainfall in 2022, though the rain blew in when we needed it most, so the vines had sufficient water for healthy growth and grape development. The spring was warm, and the summer was somewhat erratic, with cool and warm periods. We had a heat spike in late summer that pushed ripening ahead by two to three weeks, resulting in an early harvest.

## VINEYARDS

Our Chardonnay grapes are grown in two vineyards in Napa Valley – one in Los Carneros and the other in St. Helena. Just 30 miles apart, Los Carneros can be 10-15° cooler than St. Helena. Due to this difference and other important differences, such as soil type, these two vineyard sites vary significantly in character and expression. When blended, these differences in expression add layer upon layer of flavor to the nose and palate, creating a beautiful and complex Chardonnay.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

Our Reserve Chardonnay was fermented and aged in 66% stainless steel tanks and 34% French oak Burgundy barrels. Cool fermentations (52–54°F) preserve the fresh fruit aromatics. The stainless steel tanks help retain the fresh, varietal character, while the oak adds depth, texture, and complexity. We do not allow this wine to undergo malolactic fermentation to preserve the fresh aromatics and vibrant, lively acid.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2022 PlumpJack Reserve Chardonnay is a gorgeous, multi-faceted wine. The nose delivers layers of aromas—apple, baked pear, and lemon curd mingle with white peach, apricot, and honeysuckle with a dash of nutmeg and cinnamon just beneath the fruit. The palate is energetic and dynamic, beginning with a rich, mouth-filling texture reminiscent of lemon curd, followed by bright acidity that evokes lemon zest and honey-crisp apples. Finally, the beautiful acidity pulls the wine through the back of the palate, creating a long, structured finish.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

Our Merlot grapes were cold-soaked for 3-5 days before the onset of fermentation. The fermentation reached a maximum temperature of 92°F and pressed off the skins after 8–10 days before moving into oak barrels where they underwent malolactic fermentation. Of the oak barrels, 70% were new, and the balance were once-filled. Of the Merlot barrels, 90% were French Oak Bordeaux and 10% were American Oak. The coopers used include Sylvain, Taransaud, Nadalie, and Demptos. A touch of Malbec was used in the blend, adding depth and weight to the palate. The Merlot was aged for 18 months before bottling.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2019 vintage has a beautiful nose with layers of black cherry, boysenberry, black currant, and fresh-cut flowers coming through first, followed by cinnamon, cardamom, nutmeg, and a touch of cocoa. The palate, too, has great depth and complexity giving off flavors of black cherry, muddled berries, dried herbs, and dark chocolate. The palate has a creamy texture and silky tannin complimented by a fresh, vibrant acidity that lends great length to this wine.

## VINEYARDS

Our Merlot vineyard is in the Oak Knoll region of the Napa Valley, nestled up to the Mayacamas Mountain Range on the west side of the valley. This region's mild climate and alluvial soils lend this wine great balance and structure. The mild temperatures allow these grapes to develop bright aromatics and flavors and a beautiful natural acidity and elegance. The alluvial soils also bring darker fruits to the nose and palate, giving this wine structure and concentration. Our Carneros vineyard has a cooler climate, bringing an earthy, wet stone element to the nose along with beautiful fruit. The cooler temperatures help to preserve the color in the grape skins, contributing to the beauty of the wine swirling in your glass and adding depth and weight to the palate to perfectly balance the tannin.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

The grapes were cold-soaked for 3-5 days before the onset of fermentation, which reached a maximum of 92°F, then pressed off the skins after 8-9 days before moving into oak barrels and undergoing malolactic fermentation. The oak barrels were 66% new and 34% once-filled. The Merlot barrels were 90% French Oak Bordeaux and 10% American Oak. The coopers used were Sylvain, Taransaud, Nadalie, and Demptos. The touch of Malbec adds depth and weight to the palate. The Merlot aged for 18 months before bottling.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2021 PlumpJack Merlot is complex and layered. The nose leads with cherry, raspberry, and boysenberry, followed by sweet earth and dried herbs. The oak barrels bring depth to the nose by infusing notes of cinnamon, nutmeg, pie crust, vanilla, caramel, and hickory. These flavors carry through to the palate, which has a silky texture, firm yet plush tannin, and lively acidity. This wine has great length and finishes with an impression of espresso and baker's chocolate.

# 2019 PlumpJack Syrah, Napa Valley

## VINTAGE

Near record rainfall. Late budbreak. Late bloom. Late veraison. Late ripening. For the second vintage in a row, the key to the vintage was patience. The vines emerged from their dormancy later than is typical and they reached all their milestones later as well. As in 2018, it seemed the grapes would never ripen. So, we waited. Then, in early October, everything began to change. The flavors in the grapes grew deeper and richer, the skins began to grow thinner, and the color of the grapes was more easily extracted from the skins. Our patience paid off and the resulting wines are just stunning.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

We destemmed and fermented 52% of the grapes in stainless steel tanks and 23% in concrete tanks. The grapes were cold-soaked for 4 days, fermented at a maximum temperature of 92°F, and pressed off the skins after 8-10 days. The remaining 25% was whole-cluster fermented in open-top tanks and barrels, fermented at a maximum temperature of 87°F, then pressed off the skins after 6-9 days and transferred to French Oak Burgundy barrels where it underwent malolactic fermentation. The wine was kept on heavy lees for several months and stirred once a month. The coopers used were Francois Freres, Meyrieux, and Sirugue, 73% new. The wine was aged in these barrels for 16 months prior to bottling.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

This Syrah is truly a wine of place, and the character of this wine is dictated by the cooler climate of the Los Carneros growing region. The cooler weather helps the Syrah to fully develop ripe fruit character while retaining freshness and incredible spice. The nose on the 2019 PlumpJack Syrah opens with a range of fresh berries – blackberry, blueberry, boysenberry, and cranberry. Just behind the fruit is beautiful warming spice – cardamom, cinnamon, and nutmeg – along with black and white peppercorn. There are additional layers of more earthy notes – damp soil, crushed granite, and cured tobacco. The palate is full-bodied, with a round, silky texture that is beautifully framed by firm yet supple tannin. This is a beautiful and complex wine.

# 2021 PlumpJack Syrah, Napa Valley

## VINTAGE

## VINEYARD

Our Syrah grapes are grown in Los Carneros, the southernmost AVA of Napa Valley, just north of the San Pablo Bay at the northern lobe of the San Francisco Bay. These vineyards offer dramatically cooler weather than the more northern regions of Napa Valley due to the cooling effect of the San Pablo Bay, making for exceptional growing conditions for varietals such as Syrah, Merlot, and Chardonnay. The fruit from the mountainous region of Atlas Peak is at higher elevations, which also has cooler daytime temperatures than much of the valley floor. This vineyard site is on a slope with very rocky and shallow soils, which adds stress to the vines and gives us a darker fruit profile, great concentration, and firm tannin.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

Of the Syrah grapes, 46% were destemmed and fermented in stainless steel tanks and 25% in concrete tanks. These grapes

were cold soaked for 4 days, fermented at a maximum temperature of 92°F, then pressed off skins after 7 days. The remaining 29% were whole-cluster fermented in open-top tanks and barrels, fermented at a maximum temperature of 87°F, then pressed off skins after 8 days. The wine was then transferred to French Oak Burgundy barrels and underwent malolactic fermentation. The wine was kept on heavy lees for several months and stirred once a month. The coopers used include Francois Freres, Meyrieux, and Sirugue—68% were new barrels. The wine aged in these barrels for 18 months before bottling.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2021 PlumpJack Syrah is not a shy wine. The nose boasts aromatics of raspberry, cherry, blueberry, boysenberry, and plum. Intermingling with the fruit are the classic cool-climate Syrah notes—white pepper, dried herb, and smoked meats. Layered within these flavors is a unique green peppercorn element, deriving from whole-cluster fermented Syrah. The palate is packed with similar flavors and delivers a silky texture with great weight and concentration, firm tannin, and an enduring finish. This wine is simply delicious..

The flavors in the grapes grew deeper and richer, the skins began to grow thinner, the tannin became less astringent, and the color of the grapes was more easily extracted from the skins. Our patience paid off and the resulting wines are stunning.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

The Estate grapes were cold soaked for 4–6 days to coax out more color while maintaining a velvety tannin. The grapes were then fermented up to a maximum temperature of 94 °F. The wines were drained off the skins after a total maceration of 9–12 days and racked to barrel to undergo malolactic fermentation and to age. This wine was aged in 100% French oak barrels, 73% of which were new. The coopers used were primarily Sylvain, Taransaud, Cavin, and Nadalie—a blend of medium, medium-plus, and heavy toast barrels from a variety of forests, adding layers and aromatic complexity to the wine. The Estate Cabernet Sauvignon was bottled after 20 months of aging.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The nose of the 2019 PlumpJack Estate Cabernet Sauvignon bursts with juicy fruits – blackberry, dark plum, boysenberry, and muddled raspberries. These fruit aromas mingle with notes of cardamom, cinnamon, molasses, damp earth, iron, and sage. The palate has a gorgeous, silky entry also expressing notes of blackberry, plum, spice, molasses, and sage. The wine is beautifully structured with finely integrated, velvety tannin, and finishes exceptionally long.



This wine was aged in 100% French oak barrels, 78% of which were new. The coopers used were primarily Sylvain, Taransaud, Cavin, and Nadalie. The cooperage is a blend of medium, medium-plus, and heavy toast barrels from a variety of forests. This blend of coopers, forests, and toasts adds layers and aromatic complexity to the wine. The Estate Cabernet Sauvignon was bottled after 20 months of aging.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The shortage of rainfall in 2021 led to high-stress growing conditions for our vines. The resulting grapes were small and concentrated, giving us wines with great concentration, intensity, and structure. The nose of the 2021 PlumpJack Estate Cabernet Sauvignon leads with juicy fruits – black cherry, boysenberry, blackberry jam, and muddled mixed berries. The fruit is layered with fresh mint, sage, and iron filings. These aromas are complemented by warming spices, vanilla, and cocoa nib. The palate has a beautiful, velvety texture with plush tannin and an enduring finish with impressions of espresso and dark chocolate.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

The 2019 PlumpJack Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend of 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Petit Verdot, and 3% Malbec, sourced primarily from the gravelly I & K blocks on the east side of our Estate in Oakville. These blocks were subdivided and picked into smaller lots to ensure the grapes were at peak of maturity. The grapes were cold-soaked, fermented at a maximum temperature of 94°F, then pressed once the wines obtained the desired flavor, concentration, and tannin. The wines were then racked to 100% new French oak Sylvain, Darnajou, and Taransaud barrels for malolactic fermentation, then aged for 22 months before bottling.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The cooler growing season meant our grapes retained fresh fruit character, tannin, and color, which allowed us to craft a wine with great depth, energy, and freshness. The nose bursts at the seams with fresh fruit and herb, layers of boysenberry, plum, blackberry, and rhubarb, and fresh mint, sage, and tobacco leaf. Next comes the pleasant aroma of spices—nutmeg and cinnamon—adding warmth and depth to the nose. Finally, a note of espresso brings more depth and intrigue. The palate is loaded with similar flavors—plum, boysenberry, black cherry, spice, cocoa, and vanilla. This mouth-filling wine seems to expand across the palate, coating it with velvety tannin from start to finish. The beautiful acidity and silky, yet firm, tannin bring energy, life, and great length to a fantastic representation of our Estate.







Converted from open land to vineyard by Steltznors in 1970. The Steltzner vineyard was the second in the district planted to cabernet sauvignon grapes.





Intrigued by the allure of wine, he began taking wine classes alongside his biology curriculum and exploring the burgeoning wine-growing regions of the Central Coast. After gaining experience at wineries across the globe, including Stonestreet in Sonoma County for his inaugural 2012 harvest, Church Road Winery in New Zealand, Howard Park in Australia, and Gran Moraine in Oregon's Willamette Valley, Haugen joined Odette Estate Winery in 2015.

For the last eight years, Andrew has continuously honed his craft and deepened his knowledge, progressing from cellar master to enologist to assistant winemaker and now head winemaker. He oversees the daily winemaking operations for the Odette and Adaptation labels and works closely with long-time Vineyard Manager Oscar Renteria at Oso Vineyard, the 129-acre site located in Pope Valley.

## VINTAGE

In 2018 we continued to work closely with our favorite local growers throughout the broader Napa Valley. The backbone of this blend comes from Ink Grade (on the back side of Howell Mountain), which provides the framework and structure to carry this wine. This site is complemented by Oso Vineyard, which is in very close proximity, our Estate Vineyard in the Stags Leap District, Blue Tooth Vineyard down the road from Odette in Oak Knoll, and Las Amigas Vineyard in Carneros. These sites come together in unison to create a beautiful expression of Cabernet Sauvignon. This diversity and range in Napa Valley has allowed us to craft a wine which showcases the unique terroir in an approachable, elegant style.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

Fermentation took place in small fully jacketed stainless-steel fermenters after a 48-hour cold soak at 55°F. The stainless-steel fermenters showcase the purity of the fruit while preserving the freshness and allowing the terroir to shine. Maceration lasted 8-14 days at a maximum temperature of 92°F. Malolactic fermentation took place in barrel and finished up in late winter. The wine was aged in 50% new oak and 50% one-fill oak barrels with minimal racking for 18 months before bottling.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2018 Adaptation Cabernet Sauvignon is opaque purple in color, presenting notes of wild blackberries, luxardo cherries, plums, creme de cassis with hints of fresh spring flowers. This full-bodied expression displays beautiful ripeness with elegant, very fine, well integrated tannins and a gorgeous silky texture. Built for near term appreciation and long-term potential, this forward, upfront and approachable style can be enjoyed over the next decade+.

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## VINEYARDS

This Petite Sirah is crafted from two complimentary vineyards in the Napa Valley. Oso Vineyard which is located between Howell Mountain and Sugarloaf on the east side of Napa, and Langtry Vineyard located just outside of Pope Valley in the Northeastern corner of the Napa Valley. These two vineyards marry perfectly together by bringing power, elegance, structure, and grace into one, resulting in a beautiful expression of the most underrated varietals in the Napa Valley.

## VINTAGE

The growing season was extremely steady which led to balanced vines with ample airflow and the perfect amount of dappled sunlight. We had a very even bloom with version finishing quickly, resulting in a healthy, even crop that was slightly below average. Moderate temperatures held late into the season without the threat of rain, allowing for extra time to develop flavors and phenolic ripeness.

## FERMENTATION & ÉLEVAGE

Fermentation took place in small fully jacketed stainless-steel fermenters after a 48-hour cold soak at 55°F. The stainless-steel fermenters showcase the purity of the fruit while preserving the freshness and allowing the terroir to shine. Maceration lasted 6-12 days at a maximum temperature of 92°F. Malolactic fermentation took place in barrel and finished up in late winter. The wine was aged in 50% new Burgundian oak barrels and 50% one-fill oak barrels with minimal racking for 18 months before bottling.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2019 Petite Sirah exhibits the varietal's classic deep, dark purple hue, unleashing wild blackberries, mulberries, black currants, anise, and espresso beans with hints of spring flowers, cocoa powder, and oolong tea. This expressive, full-bodied wine possesses a gorgeous silky texture, nice mid-palate tension, and a long, layered finish.

# 2021 Adaptation Petite Sirah, Napa Valley

## VINEYARDS

This Petite Sirah is crafted from two complementary vineyards that showcase unique expressions of one grape. Our latest acquisition, Oso Vineyard, nestled into the warm, dry east side of the Vaca Mountains provides power and depth. Langtry Vineyard, located in the very northeastern corner of the Napa Valley adds layers of ripe fruit and energy. These two vineyards marry together perfectly by combining power and elegance to create an approachable expression of what can otherwise be an intimidating varietal.

## VINTAGE

The 2021 growing season was defined by continued drought conditions that led to lower than average yields and above average quality grapes. A warm summer and fall propelled fruit development along at a brisk pace with grapes from our warmest sites arriving shortly after Labor Day. Blue skies and even temperatures allowed us to pick each vineyard block as it achieved optimal ripeness with all our fruit harvested before a late October storm.

## FERMENTATION & ÉLEVAGE

Fermentation took place in small fully jacketed stainless steel fermenters after a 72-hour cold soak at 55°F. The stainless steel fermenters showcase the purity of the fruit, preserving freshness and allowing the terroir to shine. Maceration lasted 6-8 days at a maximum temperature of 94°F. Malolactic fermentation took place in barrel and finished in early winter. The wine was aged in 50% new Burgundian oak barrels and 50% one-fill oak barrique and puncheon with minimal racking for 18 months before bottling.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2021 Petite Sirah exhibits the varietal's classic deep, dark, purple hue, leading with aromas of blackberry liquor and luscious damson plum dusted with hints of vanilla bean and baking spice from toasted French oak barrels. Sueded tannins coat the palate while fresh acidity carries a whisper of shaved graphite and flavors of blueberry and cacao through a long, luxurious finish.



The Reserve is sourced from our hillside block and the outer edges of our 45-acre Estate in the heart of the Stags Leap AVA. The vines were planted between 1979–1990, making them some of the oldest amongst the AVA.



# 2021 Odette Reserve Chardonnay, Napa Valley

## VINEYARD

This wine is crafted from the famed Hudson Ranch off Henry Road in the Carneros AVA of Napa Valley. 2021 is the final year working with both Block 5BS and 6S. These adjacent blocks bring a combination of different attributes that harmonize beautifully in the final blend. Both parcels are planted to one of California’s most famous homegrown clones, “Old Wente”, known for its characteristic “chicks and hens” grape clusters.

## VINTAGE

The 2021 growing season is characterized by less than hoped for precipitation, low yields, and exceptional quality. Continued drought conditions restricted vigor and encouraged natural balance in the vineyard. A warm summer gave way to beautiful fall conditions that allowed our grapes to be picked at optimal ripeness and concentration.

**Varietals:** 100% Chardonnay  
**Production:** 26 Barrels  
**Alcohol:** 14.6%

## FERMENTATION & AGING

The grapes were handpicked at night and arrived at the winery before sunrise to ensure fruit integrity and preservation of delicate flavors. Both blocks were whole cluster pressed on a very gentle four-hour cycle into separate tanks and allowed to begin fermenting spontaneously by indigenous yeast. The fermenting juice was then racked to French Oak barrels where both primary and secondary malolactic fermentation took place for over 24 weeks. Each individual barrel was sur lie aged and kept separate until the final selections were ultimately determined.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2021 Odette Reserve Chardonnay was 100% barrel fermented with indigenous yeast in 70% new French Oak and sur lie aged for 16 months. The long, drawn-out fermentation preserves aromatic nuance that complements the concentrated and complex palate. Top notes of lemon custard, acacia blossom, fresh pineapple, clove, and juicy stone fruit laced with wet stone. Moderate temperatures held late into the season without the threat of rain, allowing for extra high time to develop flavors and phenolic ripeness. In 2019, a total of 25 separate picks across 32 planted acres, allowing for optimal ripeness across the entire Estate.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

Each micro-block was hand-picked, destemmed, and optically sorted. Fermentation took place in small 1-3 ton fully jacketed stainless-steel fermenters after a 48-hour cold soak at 40°F. Maceration lasted 8-14 days at a maximum temperature of 92°F. Malolactic fermentation took place in barrel and finished in late winter. The Estate blend was assembled in early 2020 and aged in 70% new French Oak for 20 months with minimal racking.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2019 Odette Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Stags Leap District, offers notes of wild blackberry compote, sweet black raspberries, black currants, crème de cassis, and licorice with hints of violets, cloves, anise, and exotic spices. This lavish, full-bodied wine is decadent and mouth filling, with copious layers that stain the palate. Vibrant acidity adds freshness and verve, complimenting the purity of fruit, leading into the long persistent finish.

# 2021 Odette Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Stags Leap District

## VINEYARD

The 2021 vintage is sourced from our 38-acre Estate Vineyard in the heart of the Stags Leap District AVA. The soils are comprised of Boomer and Perkins Gravelly Loam with a volcanic influence from the Vaca Mountain Range. The vineyard boasts 8 different clones of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Malbec, and Cabernet Franc with vines up to 41 years old. There were 23 individual picks from our Estate's 32 producing acres.

## FERMENTATION & AGING

The must was cold soaked for four days before warming tanks up for inoculation. Maceration times ranged from 7-21 days, with ferment temperatures peaking at 95°Fahrenheit. An initial base blend was assembled following the completion of malolactic fermentation in the spring of 2022. The final assemblage took place during the third racking one year later, allowing the wine time to harmonize in barrel before final racking and bottling in June 2023. The wine aged for 20 months in 100% French oak, 75% new.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2021 Odette Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Stags Leap District, opens with delicate aromas of violet and freshly ground baking spices atop layers of creme de cassis, fresh Santa Rosa plum, and luscious black cherry. On the palate, rich fruit melds seamlessly with exultant, plush tannin as a crescendo of acidity lends verve through a long finish framed by French oak.

Maceration lasted 8-14 days at a maximum temperature of 92°F. Malolactic fermentation took place in barrel and finished up in late winter. Each barrel was tasted and hand-selected for this blend, which was assembled in early 2020. The wine was aged in 90% new French Oak for 22 months with minimal racking.

## WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The 2019 Odette Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon opens with alluring notes of wild blueberries, boysenberries, black currants, a myriad of graphite, crushed rocks, and hints of star anise and spring violets. Poised and full of energy, this opulent expression of the Stags Leap District carries a remarkable sense of purity and grace, possessing seamless fine-grained tannins and notable freshness. Enjoy over the next 25+ years.
